FINANCIAL NEWS

May income was 29,203\$, compared to projected income of \$28,041. We received \$1,162 more than projected. Expenses were \$37,957, compared to a budget of \$31,498. This resulted in spending \$6459 more than budgeted. For the month, the church brought in \$8,754 less than we spent.

Year-to-date income is \$153,314, compared to projected income of \$144,930. This resulted in the church receiving \$8,384 more than projected. Expenses were \$168,613, compared to a budget of \$160,972. We have spent \$7,640 more than budgeted. For the year, the church has spent \$15,299 more than we brought in.


News from Your Visioning Team

Recently, six people from Michigan visited our companion synod in Honduras. They spent time with several different projects supported through our synod and the Lutheran Church in Honduras (ICLH).

The group spent a day with three of the twelve HIV/Aids support groups in Tegucigalpa, learning about their advocacy work and how important it was to have a place that supports and accepts them. They are often rejected by others because of their illness. They also visited homes and churches in two worshiping communities in two small villages. This included the base for a children's nutrition and health program.

Highlight of the visit was hosting a workshop for health volunteers from across Honduras. They were asked to focus on diabetes detection and care, hypertension, and stress. Volunteers learned how to address these tasks. ... The group reminded volunteers that theirs was a living response to the love of God we experience through Jesus Christ.
